



12 DAY EASTERN CANADA EXPLORER TOUR

30 AUG 25 ARRIVE TORONTO

Upon arrival into Pearson International Airport Toronto,
Own arrangements to hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Accommodation: Chelsea Hotel or similar, Toronto – 3 nights

31 AUG 25 TORONTO

Soak up the atmosphere of Toronto on a walking tour that stops at many of the city's top highlights, from the CN Tower to St. Lawrence Market. Your guide eliminates the hassle of navigating and planning an itinerary on your own and points out landmarks often missed by visitors and locals alike. At the end of the tour, walk away with a new perspective and recommendations for the rest of your stay. Max of 10 per group.

01 SEP 25 TORONTO

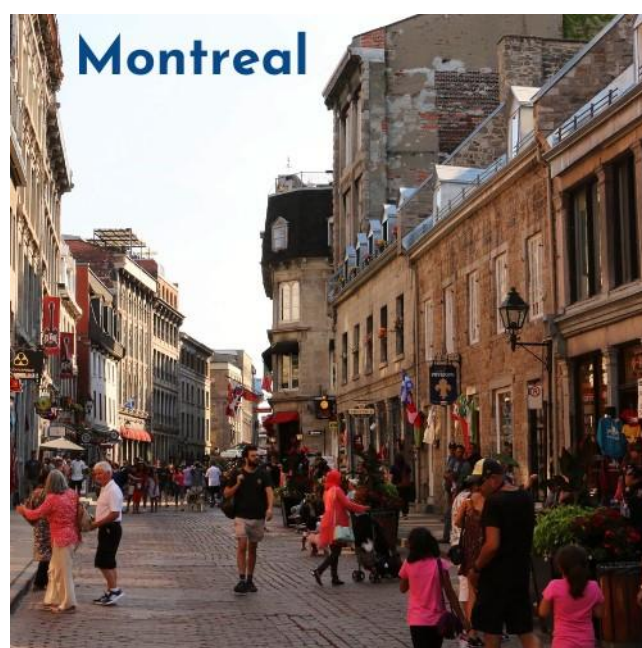
Today is at leisure to explore Toronto.

Located on the North Shore of Lake Ontario, and the capital of Ontario, Toronto is one of the world's fastest growing cities. Enjoy Toronto's waterfront – one of North America's largest recreational waterfronts, a scenic backdrop for many popular and entertaining attractions including Harbourfront, Ontario Place, Skydome, the CN Tower and the Toronto Islands. Downtown Toronto offers museums and art galleries galore including The Royal Ontario Museum (ROM), one of the top museums in the world; the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO), Canada's oldest art gallery and the Ontario Science Centre.

02 SEP 25 TORONTO – MONTREAL

Departing early, enjoy a pleasant drive east. Following the north shore of Lake Ontario, pass endless miles of rolling farmland. The first destination is the beautiful Thousand Islands resort region, embark upon a relaxing cruise. After taking in the sights and sounds of this river playground, re-board the tour coach for the drive to Montreal. Check into the hotel for a two night stay including breakfast.

Accommodation: Delta Montreal or similar – 2 nights





03 SEP 25 MONTREAL (B)

This morning, tour the second-largest French-speaking city in the world. The dynamic city of Montreal encapsulates the two founding cultures of Canada and boasts a curious blend of history and modernity. Touring the downtown area, view the Olympic Complex, charming Old Montreal, McGill University, the residential streets of Mount Royal and the bustling shopping streets. This afternoon is at leisure.

04 SEP 25 MONTREAL – QUEBEC CITY (B)

Prepare to depart from Montreal's cosmopolitan atmosphere and partially follow the route of Canada's first carriageway, the Chemin du Roy deep into French Canada. Winding through typical French-Canadian villages and towns, experience true immersion in French culture. Upon arrival in Quebec City, tour within the walls of the old city and view Lower Town, the Citadel, Battlefields Park and the ornate city gates. Continue onto the hotel and check in for a two night stay including breakfast.

Accommodation: Hotel Le Concorde or similar, Quebec City – 2 nights

05 SEP 25 QUEBEC CITY (B)

Today is at your leisure to further explore the sights of this charming World Heritage Site. You may wish to take a full day excursion (optional and at own expense) to Tadoussac including a 3-hour whale watching tour on the St. Lawrence River at the mouth of the Saguenay River. Step aboard a regular boat and go in search of the world's largest mammals. You will also visit the spectacular Montmorency Falls that are 30 metres higher than the world-famous Niagara Falls.

06 SEP 25 QUEBEC CITY – OTTAWA (B,L)

Following the shore of the St. Lawrence, this morning travel west past Montreal, across the Ontario border, and on to Ottawa — the nation's capital. stop for lunch along the way at the Sucrierie de la Montagne — an authentic sugar shack and pioneer-style restaurant. Upon arrival to Ottawa, take a quick tour of Ottawa. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Check into the hotel for a two night stay including breakfast. The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Accommodation: Delta Ottawa City Centre or similar, Ottawa – 2 nights





07 SEP 25 OTTAWA (B)

In the morning, explore Ottawa on a city tour. View the Parliament Buildings, residences of the Prime Minister and the Governor General, the Rideau Canal (designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site), and much more. The afternoon is free for independent exploration of Ottawa's many museums and fine galleries, shopping at the Sparks Street Mall or perhaps a boat cruise on one of the city's many waterways (own expense).

08 SEP 25 OTTAWA – HUNTSVILLE (B)

Today's journey west from Ottawa features sparkling lakes, rushing streams, deep forests and characteristic northern towns. The trip will be highlighted by a visit to Algonquin Provincial Park with the opportunity to take a walk along the scenic trails. This immense wildlife and forest preserve is a favourite destination for camping expeditions during the summer months and a walk will give you the opportunity to experience a little of it for yourself. Soon, enter the Muskoka resort region, check in to the hotel for an overnight stay including breakfast.

Accommodation: Super 8 by Wyndham or similar, Midland – 1 night

09 SEP 25 HUNTSVILLE – NIAGARA FALLS (B)

Drive south past Toronto and then through the orchards and vineyards of the Niagara Peninsula with a final destination of Niagara Falls. A thrilling boat ride on the Hornblower Niagara Cruises - Voyage to the Falls brings you to the foot of the thundering waterfalls for an unforgettable experience. Take a ride to the top of the Skylon Tower providing a spectacular view of the falls and the surrounding district of Niagara. There is an opportunity to enjoy an optional Niagara Helicopter Tour (own expense) or Niagara Skywheel (own expense) that gives breathtaking views of the Niagara Falls region. The evening is free for exploring North America's 'honeymoon capital'. Overnight in Niagara Falls including breakfast.

Accommodation: Hilton Hotel & Suites Fallsview or similar, Niagara Falls – 1 night

10 SEP 25 NIAGARA FALLS - TORONTO (B,D)

Leave Niagara Falls this morning following the scenic Niagara Parkway through the historic village of Niagara-on-the-Lake, home of the Shaw Festival. See a small but thriving community, proud to display a carefully-preserved nineteenth-century atmosphere. This afternoon completes the tour with a short drive back to Toronto. Check into the hotel for an overnight stay.

Accommodation: Chelsea Hotel or similar, Toronto – 1 night
