OVERVIEW

Discover why Western Australia is a nature lovers' paradise. Become an Exmouth Explorer and experience the many wonders of the World Heritage-listed Ningaloo Reef. As you journey through the idyllic West Coast you will experience a totally different side to Australia, a region many are yet to discover!

Start your adventure in the most remote capital city of Perth before heading north to experience all the wonders of the west coast. Wander through the Pinnacles Desert, see the pink lake of Hutt Lagoon, hike along the Murchison River, peek through Natures Window, watch the infamous dolphins of Monkey Mia and snorkel Ningaloo Reef with the options of swimming with Manta Rays and Whale Sharks (seasonal). This ultimate nine day exploration ventures up as far as Exmouth and encapsulates all that is great along this fantastic coastline of Australia.

ITINERARY

Day 1 - Perth to Kalbarri

Depart Perth on your journey north. Explore the [Pinnacles National Park](#) with a guided walk wandering amongst the unique and iconic West Australian landscape. Includes a stop at [Hangover Bay](#) and Nilgen Lookout. Walk along the picturesque [Jurien Bay Jetty](#), before arriving in Kalbarri for the night.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Accom: Kalbarri Edge Resort

Driving Distance: 586km

Hike Distance: 2km

Day 2 - Kalbarri

Venture into the [Kalbarri National Park](#) for sunrise at Nature's Window, the new [Skywalk](#), then take a hike into the Z bend. Afternoon spent exploring the beautiful coastline of Kalbarri, from [Pot Alley](#) to [Red Bluff](#) to the [Blue Holes](#), a fish habitat protected area (swimming and snorkeling area). Back to our accommodation where you can join a 2.5 hour afternoon river cruise up the [Murchison River](#) or sit down at [Chinamen's Beach](#) and watch the sunset.

Accom: Kalbarri Edge Resort

Options: Kalbarri Wilderness Cruises 2.5 hour (*see table below*)

Driving Distance: 200km

Hike Distance: 4km

Day 3 - Kalbarri to Monkey Mia

After breakfast, our journey takes us north into [Shark Bay World Heritage](#) area. A region with plenty of wonder to be amazed by. Take a walk along [Shell Beach](#) in Shark Bay, followed by a visit to one of three places in the world

to see oldest living fossils, known as [The Stromatolites](#). Check into Monkey Mia Resort in the afternoon of exploring.

Accom: RAC Monkey Mia Resort

Options: Didgeridoo Dreaming Night Tour, Monkey Mia Sunset Catamaran Cruise (*see table below*)

Driving Distance: 450km

Hike Distance: 4km

Day 4 - Monkey Mia to Coral Bay

In the morning, watch as the wild Dolphins of Monkey Mia come to the shore. Spot birds of prey and sharks from the coastal walk at [Eagle Bluff](#), then onto the [Little Lagoon](#) for refreshments and a quick stop in Denham. Before checking into Coral Bay for the night.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Accom: RAC Ningaloo Reef Resort

Driving Distance: 580km

Hike Distance: 2km

Day 5 - Coral Bay to Exmouth

A day at leisure to explore the surroundings of Coral Bay and Ningaloo Reef. If you're keen, jump on a reef tour and swim with Manta Rays! Departing late afternoon to spend the night in Exmouth.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Accom: Potshot Hotel & Resort - Motel

Options: Swim with Manta Rays, Snorkel Ningaloo Reef, Glassbottom boat cruise (*see table below*)

Driving Distance: 155km

Day 6 - Exmouth

Choose to join an eco tour to swim with Whale Sharks (seasonal) or explore [Cape Range National Park](#), a spectacular place of rugged limestone ranges, breathtaking deep canyons and 50km of pristine beaches. Relax on the beach or choose to go snorkelling at the stunning [Turquoise Bay](#), visit [Vlamingh Head Lighthouse](#), relax at Milyering Visitors Center and more before finishing the tour in the late afternoon.

Accom: Potshot Hotel & Resort - Motel

Options: Whaleshark Swim (*see table below*)

Driving Distance: 135km

Hike Distance: 1km

Day 7 - Exmouth to Wooramel River Retreat

Early morning starts. Stopping at Tropic of Capricorn, Blowholes coastline, [Carnarvon one mile Jetty](#), arriving at Wooramel mid afternoon. There is plenty to explore and do at this unique station, from river walking trails, bird watching or naturally heated therapeutic artesian bore baths to relax in from the Birdrong aquifer.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Accom: Wooramel River Retreat

Driving Distance: 478km

Day 8 - Wooramel River Retreat to Geraldton

Explore one or two beautiful beaches, [Horrocks](#) (rated best beach in Australia in 2018) and [Coronation Beach](#) (famous windsurfing beach), on to the [HMAS Sydney Memorial](#) with stunning views of Geraldton.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Accom: Best Western Hospitality Geraldton

Driving Distance: 422km

Day 9 - Geraldton to Perth

Take a walk along the 3 bay walk at [Green Head](#) followed by a visit to the [Lobster Shack](#), before wandering amongst the sand dunes of [Lancelin](#) or visiting Crystal Caves in the Yanchep National Park. If you're feeling adventurous, try out sandboarding for a bit of fun! Return to Perth late afternoon.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Driving Distance: 447km

We've chosen comfortable 3.5+ star resort style accommodation for this custom itinerary, except 1 night where we stay in a truly unique location and accommodation style, a definitely once-in-a-life-time experience. Mitsubishi Rosa (24-seater) vehicle makes moving people around safely and in comfort. With high-backed seats with 3-point lap-sash seatbelts and large windows for unobstructed views. BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Reserve now & pay later

Is a new feature allowing travellers to book in advance and enjoy the freedom of paying closer to the time of experience. Giving our travellers peace of mind to “lock in” and reserve a seat whilst initially planning their trip without the full upfront financial commitment.

Eligibility requirements

This feature includes all Australian Day Trips, Short Breaks and Extended Tours operated by the GLT. Some third party booking agents may not be eligible for this payment plan. If your booking is made within 30 days of the departure date, then the full amount is payable at the time of booking.

How to book

Bookings can be made over the phone or via email only. A confirmation voucher will be issued after every payment installment has been received.

Deposit requirements

Travellers are required to pay a 25% non-refundable deposit per person per trip. If your booking is made within 30 days of the departure date, then the full amount is payable at the time of booking. The deposit price is fixed and must be paid at the time of booking in order for us to reserve and confirm your seat on tour.

Final payments

Payment of the balance of the trip is due 45 days before departure date. If the balance is not paid on or before this due date, we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled and any deposit paid will be held as credit. Any credit resulting from a cancellation does not have an expiry date, and is transferable to other trips offered by GLT and not redeemable for cash. Accommodation upgrades are limited and subject to availability, we can not book and confirm upgrades until full payment has been received.

Cancellation by the traveller

- (a) unlimited free date changes available up until 30-days prior to departure; or
- (b) failure to board on tour will result in full fare forfeiture of the ticket price; or
- (c) 30-days or more prior to departure,
 - we will hold 25% deposit amount paid by you as credit and refund the remaining balance paid by you in connection to your booking less any unrecoverable costs; or
- (c) 29 days or fewer prior to departure:

- we will hold 100% of monies paid by you as credit, valid for redemption within 2 years from date of purchase
- any credit resulting from a cancellation may be applied towards any other tour operated by GLT within Australia; or

(d) if the cancellation prior to departure due to you having COVID-19/ "flu-like symptoms", supported by a medical certificate, we will refund 100% of monies paid by you either directly or via your booking agent.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Travel insurance is mandatory for all our travellers and must be taken out at the time of booking. Your travel insurance must provide cover against personal accident, death, medical expenses and emergency repatriation category cover. We also strongly recommend it covers cancellation, curtailment, personal liability and loss of luggage and personal effects.
