



## Important COVID-19 Information Update

With the closure of our Domestic and International borders we have been working extremely hard to find ways to keep our members travelling and to continue to provide new adventures for our solo travellers.

We have reintroduced some of our favorite local short breaks and have also added on some new adventures that we are sure you are going to love, some escorted by Travel with Me and others escorted by some wonderful Western Australian Tour Operators.

We want to assure you that we have the safety and well being of all our clients front of mind and as such have implemented the following operational procedures on all Travel with Me Escorted Journeys.

- Your escort, Annette Porter, has completed the Western Australian government Covid 19 hygiene training course for the delivery of tourism and hospitality experiences.
- All suppliers used across our tours will need to meet COVID regulations
- **As of 31 Jan 2022, anyone joining a Travel with Me booked tour, must show proof of vaccination to be eligible to join.**

Based on the latest health advice, from Monday, January 31, proof of vaccination requirements will apply State-wide and be expanded to include new higher-risk venues

Double dose proof of vaccination for those aged 16 and older will be required for:

- visitors to public and private hospitals, and aged care facilities;
- all hospitality venues including restaurants, cafes, bars, pubs, clubs, taverns, night clubs and dine-in fast food (roadhouses, service stations and takeaway is exempt);
- indoor entertainment venues, including play centres, gaming and gambling, theatres, concert halls, museums, cinemas and live music venues;
- bottle shops;
- the entire Crown Perth complex;
- major stadiums;
- gyms, fitness centres and health studios;
- amusement parks and the Zoo; and
- music festivals and large events with more than 500 people, unless exempt.
